

MINUTES OF THE WYNNE CITY COUNCIL  
July 8, 2025

The Wynne City Council met at Wynne City Hall on July 8, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor JENNIFER HOBBS presiding. The roll was called, and the following councilpersons answered to their names: CHRIS DAVIS, BILLY FOWLER, RICKY MCDANIEL, STEVIE NELSON, LESTER MILLER, JOSHUA WYATT, BUCK MORRIS, LISA CARTER, JASON NICHOLS, and TYLER WAYMIRE; a quorum was declared. City Clerk, Emily Watts, was present. City Attorney, Kevin A. Watts, was present.

On the motion of Councilperson Morris and seconded by Councilperson Nelson and by consent of all Members present, the minutes of a regular council meeting held on June 10, 2025, were approved, accepted, and filed as prepared by the City Clerk.

Richard Dennis, Wynne Police Department, Kyle Frymire, Public Works, Jase Long, Parks & Recreation, Kory Ward, Wynne Fire Department, and Jennifer Hobbs, Mayor all provided monthly reports. On the motion of Councilperson Morris and seconded by Councilperson Nelson, and by consent of all members present, the department reports presented were approved and accepted.


For the First item of business, Mayor Hobbs presented and read in its entirety Resolution 7-8-25A, "a resolution authorizing the Mayor of Wynne to apply for a grant on behalf of the Wynne Parks & Recreation Department." After further discussion, Councilperson Morris, with a second by Councilperson Waymire, made a motion to approve Resolution 7-8-25A. With the consent of all members present, Resolution 7-8-25A was passed and approved.

For the Second item of business, Mayor Hobbs presented and read in its entirety Resolution 7-8-25B, "a resolution authorizing the Mayor of Wynne to apply for a grant on behalf of the Wynne Fire Department." After further discussion, Councilperson Morris, with a second by Councilperson Nichols, made a motion to approve Resolution 7-8-25B. With the consent of all members present, Resolution 7-8-25B was passed and approved.


For the Third item of business, Fire Chief Kory Ward asked the Council approval to purchase an air compressor in the amount of \$33,883.41 and air filler in the amount of \$15,131.06 from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, Denton, TX. After further discussion, Councilperson Nichols, with a second by Councilperson Wyatt, made a motion to approve the expenditure. With the consent of all members present, the motion was approved.

For the Fourth item of business, Mayor Hobbs asked the Council approval to upgrade the City of Wynne website. After further discussion, Councilperson Davis, with a second by Councilperson Morris, made a motion to approve option B to upgrade the website and use an app that integrates with the website with Brooks Jeffrey Marketing, Inc. This package costs \$5,995: \$2,495 for an annual website hosting fee, \$1,995 annual app subscription, one-time fee of \$100 for a setup of .gov domain, and \$55 fee to redirect .org to .gov domain. With the consent of all members present, the motion was approved.

With no further business before the council and upon motion by Councilperson Wyatt, second by Councilperson Miller, and consent of all, the meeting adjourned.
